### TOWN OF CUTLER BAY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AMENDMENT TO SIGN REGULATIONS

The Town of Cutler Bay will be holding a public hearing on **Wednesday, November 20, 2013 at 7 p.m. at the Town of Cutler Bay Town Chambers, 10720 Caribbean Boulevard, Cutler Bay, FL 33189**, to consider the adoption on second reading of the following Ordinance:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ARTICLE III "SIGN REGULATIONS" AND THE DEFINITIONS OF THE TOWN LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, IN ORDER TO AMEND THE TOWN'S REGULATIONS OF SIGNS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

The proposed Ordinance may be inspected by the public at the Town Clerk's Office at 10720 Caribbean Boulevard, Suite 105, Cutler Bay, FL 33189. Interested parties are invited to attend the public hearing or provide written comments to the Town Council.

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), persons needing special accommodations to participate in these proceedings should contact the Town Clerk's office for assistance at (305) 234-4262 no later than four business days prior to such proceeding.

If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the town council, with respect to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, that person will need a record of the proceedings and, for such purpose, may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made; such record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based (F.S. 286.0105).
