



History of Funded Legislative Appropriations

Fiscal Year: 2020

2020-03

The Town of Cutler Bay supports continued funding of the Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP). The Town further supports funding to local governments recovering from the various Hurricane's that occurred since 2017.

The Town was awarded \$200,000 in grant funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's FRDAP Program for the "Franjo Park Restoration" project. Franjo Park has been closed since Hurricane Irma in September 2017.

Fiscal Year: 2019

2019-01

The Town of Cutler Bay supports grant and legislative line item funding that enhances local financial capacity to address water resource and water supply development. The Town further supports enhanced funding of the Water Protection and Sustainability Program within the Department of Environmental Protection for comprehensive water supply infrastructure needs.

The Town was awarded a \$200,000 legislative appropriation in the State Budget for "Drainage Project-Cutler Ridge Section 3". This project was identified during a series of two (2) public input meetings in February 2017.

Project identified in the Town's 2015 Local Mitigation Strategy (Town Resolution No. 14-55; updated annually).

Fiscal Year: 2018

2018-07

The Town of Cutler Bay supports grant and legislative line-item funding that enhances local financial capacity to address water resource and water supply development. The Town further supports enhanced funding of the Water Protection and Sustainability Program within the Department of Environmental Protection for comprehensive water supply infrastructure needs.

The Town was awarded a \$250,000 legislative appropriation in the State Budget Request for "Drainage Project-Saga Bay 1.7".

Project identified in the Town's 2014 Local Mitigation Strategy (Town Resolution No. 14-55; updated annually), the Town's 2008 Stormwater Master Plan (Town Resolution No. 08-50), and the Town's Flood Mitigation Plan.

Fiscal Year: 2017

2017-01

The Town of Cutler Bay supports grant and legislative line item funding that enhances local financial capacity to address water resource and water supply development. The Town further supports enhanced funding of the Water Protection and Sustainability Program within the Department of Environmental Protection for comprehensive water supply infrastructure needs.

*The Town was awarded a **\$165,250** legislative appropriation in the State Budget Request for “Drainage Project-Saga Bay 1.2”.*

Project identified in the Town’s 2014 Local Mitigation Strategy (Town Resolution No. 14-55; updated annually), and the Town’s 2008 Stormwater Master Plan (Town Resolution No. 08-50).

Fiscal Year: 2016

2016-04

The Town of Cutler Bay supports grant and legislation line item funding for the Florida Department of Environmental Protection as a successful funding vehicle for local government park development and recreational efforts and has helped leverage local dollars.

*The Town was awarded **\$200,000** in grant funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection’s Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) for the “Lakes by the Bay Canoe/Kayak Launch and Parking Facilities”.*

Project identified in the Town’s 2009 Parks Master Plan (Town Resolution No. 09-15).

2016-01

The Town of Cutler Bay supports grant and legislative line item funding that enhances local financial capacity to address water resource and water supply development. The Town further supports enhanced funding of the Water Protection and Sustainability Program within the Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for comprehensive water supply infrastructure needs.

*The Town was awarded **\$374,000** in grant funding from the FDEP - Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) program to support the “Stormwater Retrofit Project – SW 100 Avenue/Port Royale”.*

Project identified in the Town’s 2014 Local Mitigation Strategy (Town Resolution No. 14-55; updated annually), and the Town’s 2008 Stormwater Master Plan (Town Resolution No. 08-50).

Fiscal Year: 2013

2013-01

The Town of Cutler Bay supports grant and legislative line item funding that enhances local financial capacity to address water resource and water supply development. The Town further supports enhanced funding of the Water Protection and Sustainability Program within the Department of Environmental Protection for comprehensive water supply infrastructure needs.

The Town was awarded a **\$300,000** legislative appropriation in the *State Budget for “Stormwater Retrofit Project – SW 212 Street/Cutler Bay High Drainage Improvement”*. Additionally, a funding request application was submitted to the Florida Department of Transportation and was awarded **\$400,000**.

Project identified in the Town's 2008 Stormwater Master Plan (Town Resolution No. 08-50).
