## **RESOLUTION NO. 20-**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, CONFIRMING EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 20-06, EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 20-07, AMENDMENT 1 TO EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 20-06, AND AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 20-07 DUE TO THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) PANDEMIC; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in late 2019, a new significant outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) emerged throughout the World and was declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern by the World Health Organization; and

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2020, the State Surgeon General and State Health Officer declared a Public Health Emergency exists in the State of Florida as a result of COVID-19 and confirmed eight (8) counties in Florida (including Miami-Dade County) to have tested positive for the disease; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order No. 20-52 declaring a State of Emergency due to COVID-19, and on March 12, 2020, Miami-Dade County Mayor Carlos A. Gimenez issued a County-wide Declaration of a State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 12, Article II, Section 12-23 of the Town of Cutler Bay's (the "Town") Code of Ordinances states, "The Town Manager shall have the sole authority to declare a state of emergency hereunder [...] Any declaration of a state of emergency and all emergency regulations activated under the provisions of this article and any emergency expenditures made hereunder pursuant to section 12-22 (9) shall be confirmed by the Town Council by Resolution no later than the next regular meeting, or as reasonably as possible, unless the nature of the emergency renders a meeting of the Town Council impossible"; and

WHEREAS, during the April 22, 2020 Regular Town Council meeting, the Town Council adopted Resolution No. 20-15, confirming the Town Manager's Declaration of State of Emergency and Emergency Orders No. 20-01 (Facial Coverings), 20-02 (Zoning in Progress), and 20-03 (Rules of Procedure for Public Meeting) for the Town due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, during the May 20, 2020 Regular Town Council Meeting, the Town Council adopted Resolution No. 20-25, confirming the Town Manager's Emergency Order No. 20-04 (Park Closures) for the Town due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, during the June 17, 2020 Regular Town Council Meeting, the Town Council adopted Resolution No. 20-29, confirming the Town Manager's Emergency Order No. 20-05 (Outdoor Dining Expansion), Amendment No. 1 (Park Reopening) and Amendment No. 2 (Park Reopening) to Emergency Order No. 20-04 for the Town due to COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS,** on June 25, 2020 the Town Manager issued Emergency Order No. 20-06 to provide procedures for virtual Quasi-Judicial Hearings, which Order was sent to the Town Clerk's Office for posting and distribution to local media outlets (Exhibit "A"); and

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2020 the Town Manager issued Emergency Order No. 20-07 to repeal Emergency Order No. 20-01 and adopt more stringent standards regarding facial coverings, which Order was sent to the Town Clerk's Office for posting and distribution to local media outlets (Exhibit "B"); and

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2020 the Town Manager issued Amendment No. 1 to Emergency Order No. 20-06 to amend the virtual Quasi-Judicial Hearing procedures, which Order was sent to the Town Clerk's Office for posting and distribution to local media outlets (Exhibit "C"); and

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2020 the Town Manager issued Amendment No. 1 to Emergency Order No. 20-07 to repeal Emergency Order No. 20-07 in its entirety and replaced it with the adopted Amendment No. 1 to Miami-Dade County Emergency Order No. 20-20 relating to masks or other facial coverings, which Order was sent to the Town Clerk's Office for posting and distribution to local media outlets (Exhibit "D"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the residents of the Town.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals.</u> The above Recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Confirmation.</u> In accord with section 12-23 of the Town's Code, the Town Council hereby confirms the Town Manager's issuance of Emergency Order No. 20-06, Emergency Order No. 20-07, Amendment No. 1 to Emergency Order No. 20-06, and Amendment No. 1 to Emergency Order No. 20-07.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
