

RESOLUTION 13-_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 13-76 RELATING TO THE ELEVATOR MODERNIZATION AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) 13-06; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO RE-ADVERTISE A RFP FOR SUCH SERVICES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2013, the Town of Cutler Bay (the “Town”) issued Request for Proposal (RFP) 13-06 relating to Elevator Modernization and Maintenance Services for the Town Center Building; and

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2013, the Town Council adopted Resolution 13-76 awarding the contract for the Elevator Modernization and Maintenance Services for the Town Center Building (the “Resolution”); and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Resolution, the Town Attorney and Town Manager became aware of irregularities in the procurement process relating to RFP 13-06; and

WHEREAS, as such, the Town Council desires to rescind the Resolution and authorize the Town Manager to re-advertise for proposals for the Elevator Modernization and Maintenance Services for the Town Center Building; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the residents of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Rescinding Resolution 13-76. The Town Council hereby rescinds Resolution 13-76.

Section 3. Authorization. The Town Council hereby authorizes the Town Manager to re-advertise for proposals for the elevator modernization and maintenance services for the Town Center Building.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
