



TOWN OF CUTLER BAY AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO EMERGENCY ORDER 20-04

The effects of COVID-19 continue to require extraordinary and immediate actions by the Town in order to further protect our residents' health, safety and welfare. The Town's parks and recreational facilities are potential gathering places for the spread of COVID-19. ~~Additionally, based on the data related to the number of new COVID-19 cases within Miami-Dade County and associated hospitalizations that this is not the appropriate time to begin reducing public safety measures intended to protect our Town residents.~~ The data collected by the Florida Department of Health indicates the State has achieved several critical benchmarks in flattening the curve, including a downward trajectory of hospital visits for influenza-like illness and COVID-19-like syndromic cases, a decrease in percent positive test results, and a significant increase in hospital capacity since the issuance of Miami-Dade County Emergency Order No. 20-21.

By virtue of the powers and duties vested in me as the Town Manager of the Town of Cutler Bay, Miami-Dade County, Florida, in accordance with Section 252.38 of the Florida Statutes, under Chapter 12, Article II, Sec. 12-23 (a) of the Town Code, and pursuant to the Town's Declaration of a State of Emergency issued on March 13, 2020, ~~I hereby find that it would further mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus and I hereby find that it will~~ serve the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Cutler Bay to order the following:

All Town owned Parks and Recreational Facilities *shall remain closed, except for:*

- Lakes by the Bay Park | 8551 SW 216 Street
- Cutler Ridge Park | 10100 SW 200 Street

The above referenced Parks and Recreational Facilities shall reopen subject to the restrictions set forth in Miami-Dade County Emergency Order No. 21-20. Notwithstanding the foregoing:

- Restroom facilities shall remain closed:
- Parking lots shall remain closed: and
- Water fountains shall remain closed.

No person shall violate the terms of this Emergency Order, except upon direct authorization of the Town of Cutler Bay Police Department. Any violation of this Emergency Order shall be subject to fine, imprisonment, or both.

This Emergency Order shall be effective **commencing May 19, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. (EST)** and shall continue in effect from day-to-day until the State of Emergency issued on March 13, 2020 is declared to be terminated by the Town Manager or Town Council in accordance with Section 12-24 of the Town Code. This Emergency Order may be cancelled earlier by action of the Town Manager.


