

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-\_\_\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA REQUESTING THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC WORKS TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 35 MPH TO 30 MPH ALONG THE S.W. 87<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE CORRIDOR BETWEEN OLD CUTLER ROAD AND S.W. 244<sup>TH</sup> STREET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on June 15, 2017, the Town of Cutler Bay (the “Town”) Council adopted Resolution No. 16-35, urging the Miami-Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works (the “DTPW”) to conduct a traffic study along the S.W. 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue corridor between S.W. 184<sup>th</sup> Street and S.W. 244<sup>th</sup> Street; and

**WHEREAS**, in response to Resolution No. 16-35, the DTPW conducted a traffic study and, on March 9, 2018, advised the Town that DTPW would reduce the speed limit on S.W. 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Old Cutler Road and S.W. 244<sup>th</sup> Street from 40 MPH to 35 MPH and install appropriate signs to reflect the new speed limit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town continues to be concerned that the speed limit in the corridor of S.W. 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Old Cutler Road and S.W. 244<sup>th</sup> Street is unnecessarily high, and that the speed limit should be further lowered to 30 MPH to protect pedestrians, cyclists, and wildlife; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town requests that the DTPW reduce the speed limit to 30 MPH along S.W. 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Old Cutler Road and S.W. 244<sup>th</sup> Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that this Resolution is in the best interest of the Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2.** **Request.** The Town requests that the DTPW reduce the speed limit to 30 MPH along S.W. 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Old Cutler Road and S.W. 244<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Section 3.** **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
