AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO EMERGENCY ORDER 20-04

The effects of COVID-19 continue to require extraordinary and immediate actions by the Town in order to further protect our residents' health, safety and welfare. The Town's parks and recreational facilities are potential gathering places for the spread of COVID-19. The data collected by the Florida Department of Health indicates the State has achieved several critical benchmarks in flattening the curve, including a downward trajectory of hospital visits for influenza-like illness and COVID-19-like syndromic cases, a decrease in percent positive test results, and a significant increase in hospital capacity since the issuance of Miami-Dade County Emergency Order No. ~~20-2128-20~~.

By virtue of the powers and duties vested in me as the Town Manager of the Town of Cutler Bay, Miami-Dade County, Florida, in accordance with Section 252.38 of the Florida Statutes, under Chapter 12, Article II, Sec. 12-23 (a) of the Town Code, and pursuant to the Town's Declaration of a State of Emergency issued on March 13, 2020, I hereby find that it will serve the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Cutler Bay to order the following:

No person shall violate the terms of this Emergency Order, except upon direct authorization of the Town of Cutler Bay Police Department. Any violation of this Emergency Order shall be subject to fine, imprisonment, or both.




