

**RESOLUTION 17-\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE SAFETY ENFORCEMENT CAMPAIGN GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,736.80; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH FLORIDA BOARD OF TRUSTEES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cutler Bay (“Town”) applied for funding from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) through a grant with the University of South Florida to promote the “Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Enforcement Campaign”; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the “Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Enforcement Campaign” is to utilize law enforcement support to educate and enforce safe pedestrian, bicyclist, and driver behaviors in priority counties in Florida, including Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council desires to accept a grant from the University of South Florida’s Center for Urban Transportation Research in an amount not to exceed \$9,736.80; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with the University of South Florida’s Center for Urban Transportation Research to improve the safety of residents and visitors through enhanced traffic education and enforcement operations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town finds that this resolution will promote the health, safety and welfare of the Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals Adopted.** That each of the above stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

**Section 2. Grant Accepted.** The acceptance of the grant in the amount of \$9,736.80 from the University of South Florida, as a sub-recipient of an award from the Florida Department of Transportation, in substantially the form attached as Exhibit “A,” is hereby approved.

**Section 3. Manager Authorized.** The Town Manager is hereby authorized to take all action necessary to enter into and execute the grant Agreement between the Town and the University of South Florida Board of Trustees for the “Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Enforcement Campaign,” in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” on behalf of the Town, subject to the Town Attorney’s approval as to form, content and legal sufficiency.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption hereof.
