

RESOLUTION 17-

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA,
APPOINTING A MEMBER TO THE YOUTH COUNCIL
COMMITTEE AS PROVIDED IN EXHIBIT “A;” AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2012, the Town of Cutler Bay (the “Town”) Town Council (the “Council”) adopted Resolution 12-63 creating the Youth Council Committee (the “Committee”) to advise and make appropriate recommendations to the Town Council regarding issues of special interest to youths within the Town; and

WHEREAS, on August 21, 2013, the Town Council adopted Resolution 13-62 amending Resolution 12-63 relating to the Youth Council Committee Appointments; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Committee is to stimulate community service and foster a better understand among young people of how municipal government works; and

WHEREAS, Vice Mayor Loyzelle’s appointment to the Committee is no longer a resident, resulting in a vacant position and has provided a committee appointment to fill the position; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the adoption of this Resolution is in the best interest of the Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. **Appointment of Committee Members.** The Town Council hereby appoints a Committee member to fill a vacancy as shown on Exhibit “A.”

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
