#15) An amendment to provide that the town council shall endeavor to adopt and implement policies to protect natural resources, including but not limited to wetlands within the town, and to encourage others to do the same, and that the town shall be mindful of its role in the global community and as a steward of the earth, and act accordingly.

A question I put forward, can we require a designated wet land property be put to a referendum, vote of the community for purposes of development?
