2018 Public Land Acquisition & Management Conference

- From Monday, October 1, 2018- Wednesday, October 3, 2018, Town Manager Casals attended the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) 2018 Public Land Acquisition and Management (PLAM) Partnership One Florida Conference in Sarasota, FL.
- ➤ PLAM is a statewide conference that focuses on public land acquisition and management issues in Florida. Topics of the conference include conversation panels and workshops, such as working land and water partners, military partners, connecting communities, data-driven decisions for conservational planning, leadership-future of conservation, and much more.



➤ Town Manager Casals learned of additional resources and possible funding opportunities that will coincide with the DEP mission to protect, conserve and manage Florida's natural resources and enforce the state's environmental laws.

Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Training



- ➤ On Thursday, October 4, 2018, the Town's senior management staff attended the Equal Opportunity Commission (EEOC) Compliance Training that was hosted by Mr. David M. Alba.
- During the training, the team learned various aspects of the U.S. EEOC, such as the definition and importance of the EEOC, reasonable accommodations as it applies to the Americans with Disabilities Act, major federal case laws, applying EEOC in the workplace, the responsibility of supervisors when it comes to the workplace environment, and much more.

Miami-Dade College Scholarship Informational Sessions



- ➤ The Town hosted the Miami-Dade College School of Continuing Education & Professional Development Fall 2018 Scholarship Informational Sessions in partnership with Miami Dade College and the Early Learning Career Center (formerly known as Quality Counts).
- Town Manager Casals welcomed the child care staff attendees and thanked the Children's Forum and The Children's Trust for supporting the Scholarship Informational Sessions.
- Attendees learned of new courses that help enhance the learning of those in the childhood field, and scholarships available to them.

CPR Staff Workshop

- ➤ On October 10, 2018 and October 11, 2018, Town staff attended the Adult and Pediatric Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and the Automated External Defibrillator (AED) workshop.
- > The workshops were specific to new certifications and re-certifications of current staff.
- ➤ In this workshop, staff learned to properly assess emergency situations and effective techniques in order to administer appropriate aide while waiting for emergency medical personnel to arrive to the scene.
