Thank you for submitting your grant proposal entitled "Saga Bay 1.7 Sub-Basin Water Quality Improvement Project" for funding consideration from the nonpoint source grant management program.

We are pleased to inform you that your project has been accepted for state funding in the amount of **\$600,000** and based on local contributions pledged towards the total project costs: **\$355,539** from the Town of Cutler Bay. You will be contacted shortly in order to initiate a cost-reimbursement grant agreement. Please be aware that any funds spent prior to agreement execution are not eligible for reimbursement; however, they may be used as match in certain situations.
