### REQUEST

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE FEASIBILITY AND ADVISABILITY OF PROVIDING LOCATIONS, SUCH AS MIAMI-DADE POLICE STATIONS OR OTHER LOCATIONS THAT WOULD DETER CRIMINAL ACTIVITY, TO SERVE AS SAFE HAVENS IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR ANYONE SEEKING TO COMPLETE A CRAIGSLIST TRANSACTION OR SIMILAR TRANSACTION RELATED TO A CLASSIFIED ADVERTISEMENT WEBSITE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

### BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

I urge my fellow Council Members to pass this Resolution in support of Miami-Dade County Commissioner Sally A. Heyman (sponsor) in examining the feasibility and advisability of providing Safe Havens in at least four (4) Miami-Dade County Police Stations for internet sales transactions related to classified advertisements websites in an effort to make our local community safer as it relates to these types of transactions.
