The third public meeting for the Town Center Plaza project took place at Cutler Bay City Hall on July 27th, 2016 at 6:00pm.

The purpose of the 3rd public meeting was to receive community input on the proposed concepts for the Town Center Plaza. Kimley-Horn and Associates presented two design options that reflected the most voted amenities and activities from the previous workshops feedback. Residents of Cutler Bay participated and the following are comments provided during the 3rd public meeting:

- Residents preferred option B
- Talk to Mall about the project and get them familiarized with it and propose possible agreements for parking use.
- Extend the use of solar panels over stage and restrooms
- Restrooms to include family restrooms
- Add more shading structures to the exercise equipment area
- Incorporate some seating within skate park for viewers
- Residents like the idea of incorporating a dog park next to the skate park area.
- Reduce the quantity of palms and add more shade trees
- Portions of the different walks throughout the project to be rubberized material.
- Add fencing along the Turnpike edge
- Increase shade over open lawn event area







Cost to Operate:

- One Park Service Aid (PSA): 25 hours/week; Salary: \$20,508.75 /year including benefits
- Insurance: \$500/year

Total Cost: \$21,008.75 /year
