**Re:** Floodplain Mitigation Advisory Committee  
Flood Mitigation Project List Status Report (2015 First Quarter Report)

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On March 31, 2015 the Flood Mitigation Advisory Committee, held their 2015 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Meeting, to discuss the update of the Town’s adopted Floodplain Mitigation Plan (the “FMP”). Attached for your review is a summary of the items discussed, during the Advisory Committee meeting (*Attachment “A”*). Town staff developed and presented a complete review of all seventeen (17) mitigation projects (*Attachment “B”*) included in the Town’s FMP which, was adopted via Town Resolution # 14-73. The Floodplain Mitigation Advisory Committee members reviewed each mitigation action item (project) identified in the Town’s FMP. Within each of the seventeen (17) projects, Town staff provided a detailed summary which included the following information:

- Project Description
- Project Benefits
- Project Status

The Flood Mitigation Project List Status Report (the “Report”) indicates the total cost for the project, local operating budget to support the project, and grants that have been applied for to also help fund and support the project. Additionally, if any Town staff time is required to complete or assist in a project, no budget is applied to this item within this report but, was included in the FMP.

The Report fulfills the requirements of FEMA’s National Flood Insurance Program’s (NFIP) Community Rating System (CRS) for providing a quarterly review of the implementation status of the action plan (projects) within the Town’s adopted Floodplain Mitigation Plan.

Additionally, the Report will be posted on the Town’s website and on-file in the Public Works Department, for public inspection and/or review. The Report will also be submitted to the following “local” newspapers: Cutler Bay Community News, South Dade News Leader, and the Miami Herald, to further inform our residents and business owners of our progress.
