RESOLUTION 17-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, APPOINTING A MEMBER TO THE FLOODPLAIN MITIGATION PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2013, the Town of Cutler Bay (the "Town") Town Council (the "Council") adopted Resolution 13-56 creating the Floodplain Mitigation Plan Advisory Committee (the "Committee") for purposes of developing a plan to minimize the Town's vulnerability to flooding, while protecting the natural and beneficial functions of the floodplain; and

WHEREAS, the Committee assisted the Town in developing the Floodplain Mitigation Plan, adopted via Resolution 14-73 as well as the revised Floodplain Mitigation Plan, adopted via Resolution 15-27; and

WHEREAS, the Committee currently has a vacancy resulting from the resignation of a Committee member; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to appoint a new member to fill the vacancy on the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that adopting this Resolution is in the best interest of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. Appointment of Committee Member. The Council hereby appoints a member to the Committee to fill a vacancy as shown by "Exhibit A," attached hereto.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
