
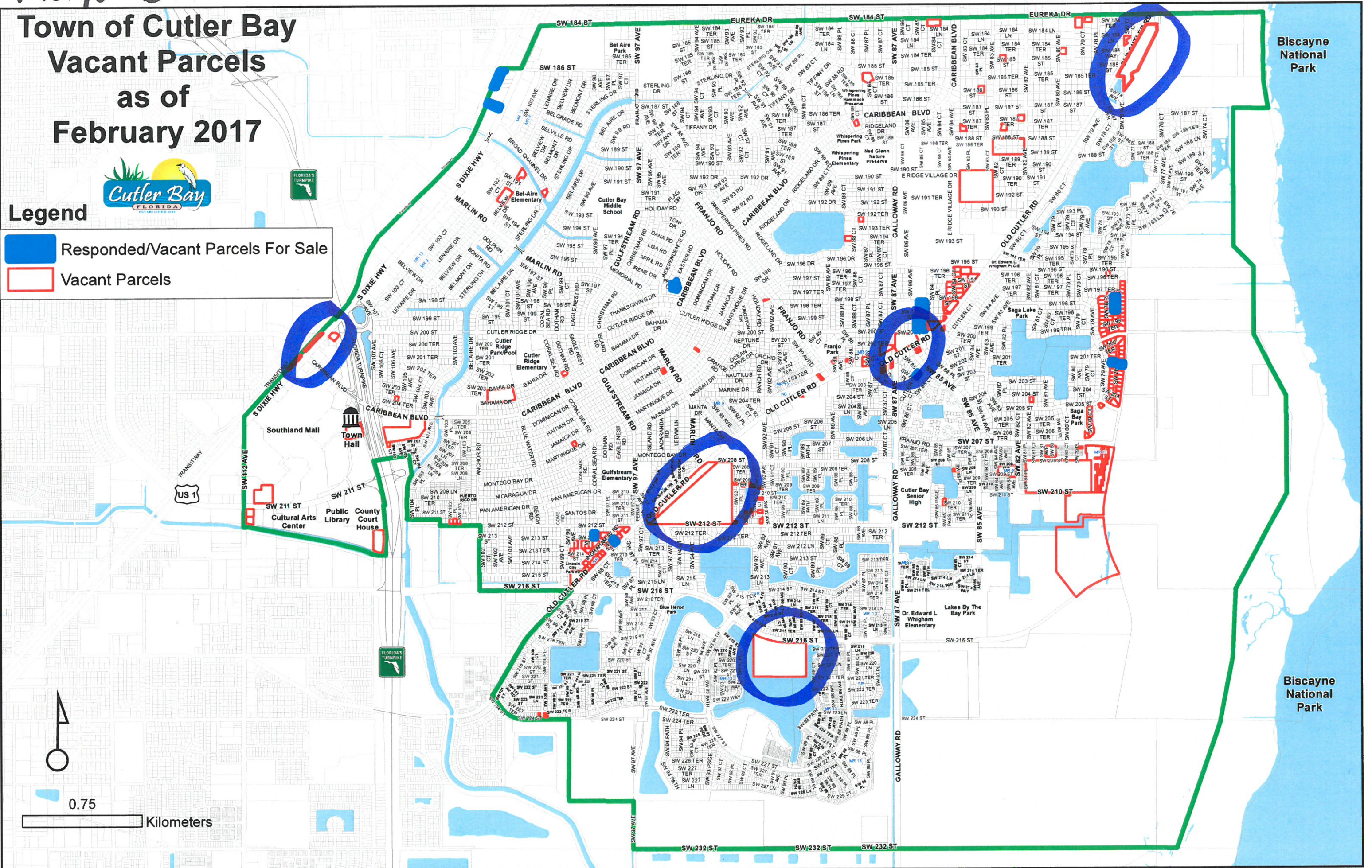


Town of Cutler Bay Vacant Parcels as of February 2017

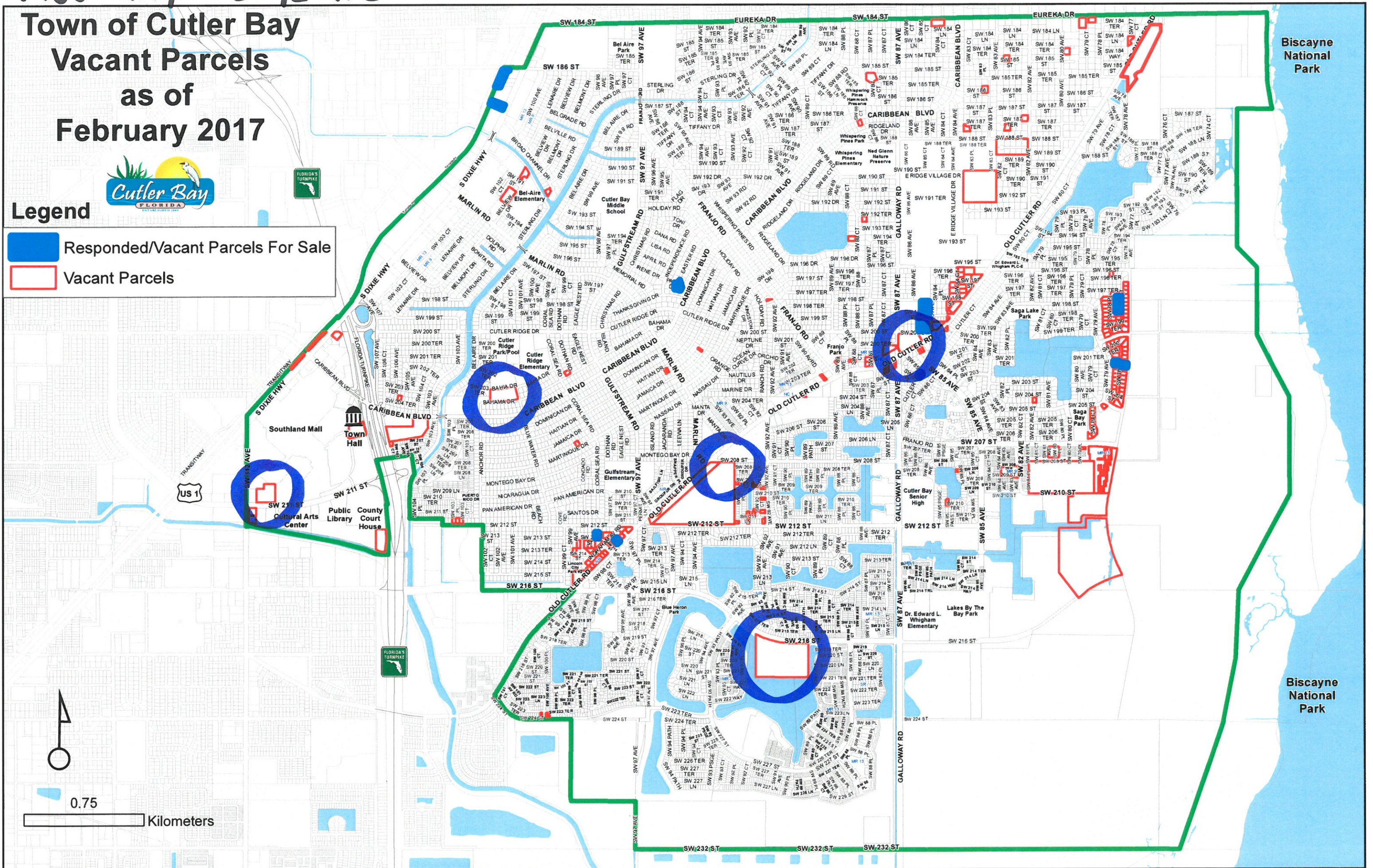


Town of Cutler Bay Vacant Parcels as of February 2017

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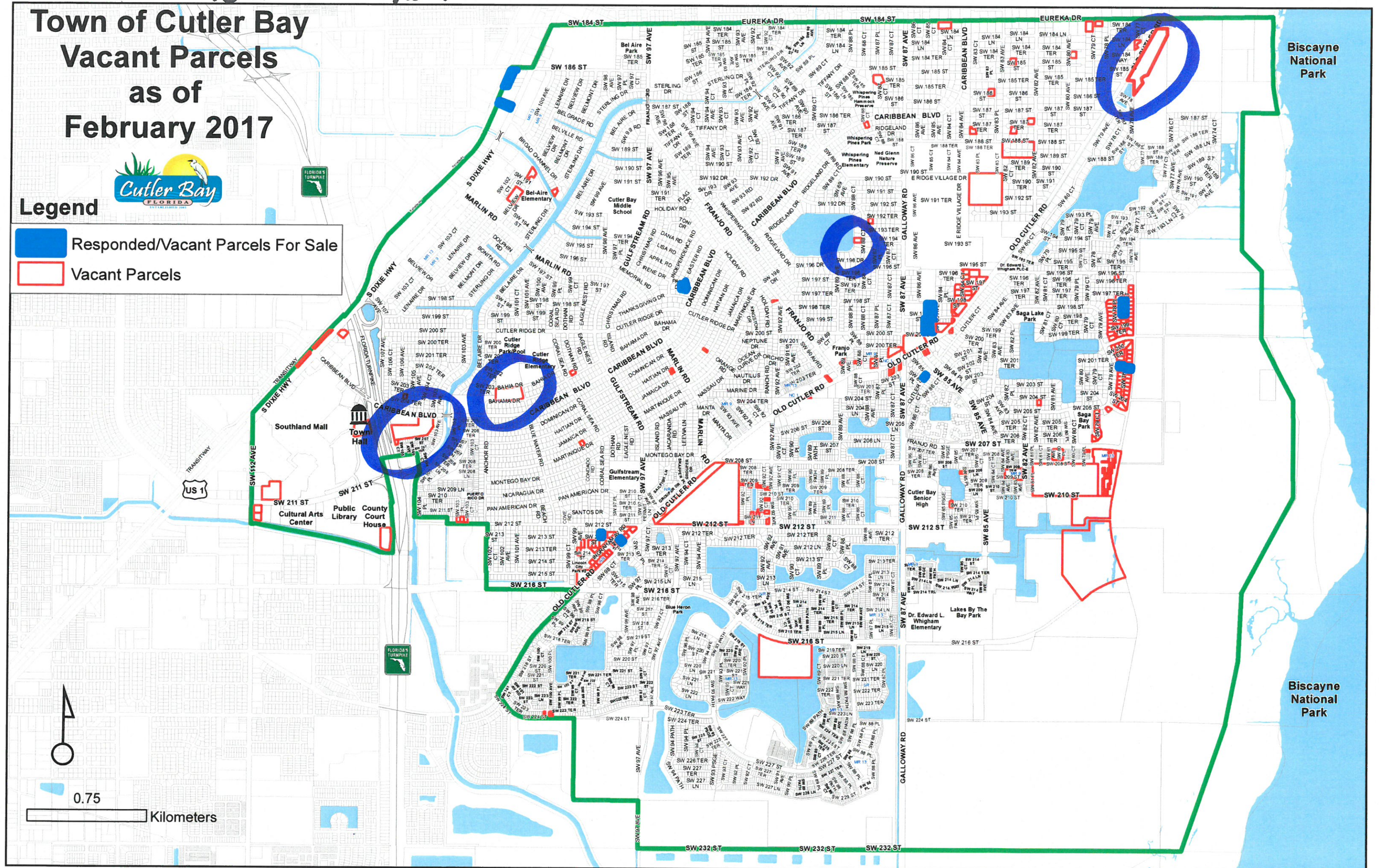


Town of Cutler Bay Vacant Parcels as of February 2017

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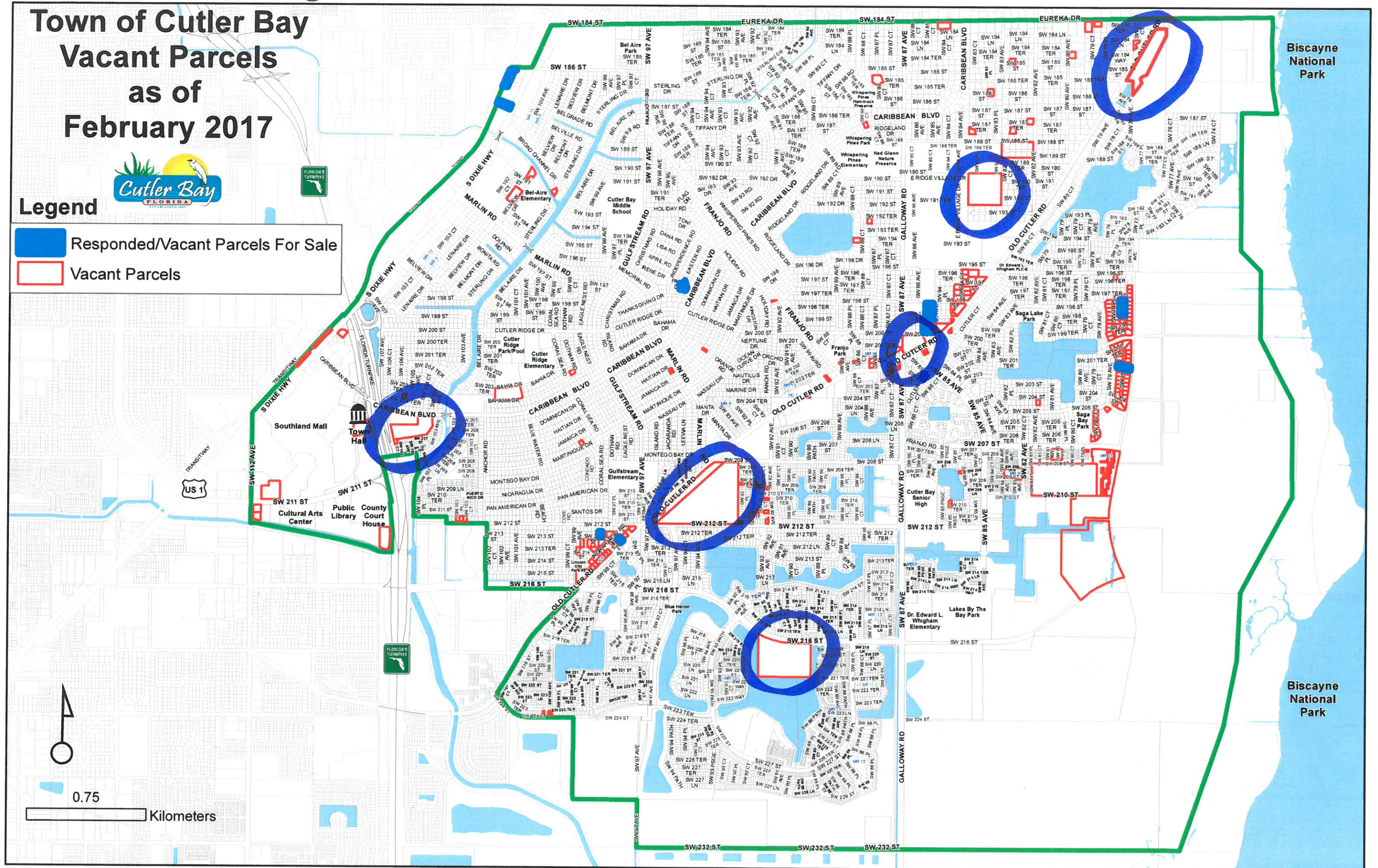
