NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. Recitals. The above Recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Authorization. The Town Manager is hereby authorized to advertise and issue a RFQ for professional general planning consulting services for the Town, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
