DISCOVER OUR PARKS

BEL-AIRE PARK

18500 SW 97 Avenue Bel Aire Park is a 5-acre park that is the home of the Palmetto Raiders Youth Development Club tackle football and cheerleading program.

BLUE HERON PARK

21900 SW 97 Avenue The park sits adjacent to one of the many man-made lakes in the Lakes by the Bay Community. The park includes a well-shaded $\!$ mile long paved multi-use path popular with walkers, joggers and bicyclists

CUTLER RIDGE PARK AND POOL

10100 SW 200 Street The park is home to the Cutler Ridge Soccer Club, the Riptides Swim and Water Polo teams and Big Gator Swim Club. The park consists of a recreation building, swimming pool, athletic fields, picnic pavilion, and

FRANJO PARK

20175 Franjo Road he park is the long-time home of the Perrine Baseball and Softball Association.

LAKES BY THE BAY

8551 SW 216 Street The park consists of three baseball/softball fields, 4 batting cages, two soccer/football/lacrosse fields, a .6 mile exercise path, covered playground and concession building

LINCOLN CITY PARK

SW 212 Street & SW 99 Avenue Lincoln City Park is maintained as a natural area with an abundance of native species including live oak and slash pines.

SAGA BAY PARK

8000 SW 205 Street The park contains 4 lighted tennis courts, a covered playground, a paved walking path.

SAGA LAKE PARK SW 198 Street & SW 83 Avenue This park contains a picnic pavilion and is perfect for relaxing in the shade. It also includes a paved fitness path and a practice baseball/softball field.

WHISPERING PINES PARK 8800 Ridgeland Drive The park is adjacent to Whispering Pines Elementary School and the Ned Glenn Preserve. The park contains a covered playground and picnic pavilion and is the gathering point for the Whispering Pines 4th of July Parade.
