Code Compliance

Code Compliance Special Magistrate Hearing was held on May 9, 2017. Fourteen (14) cases were heard at the hearing. The Special Magistrate upheld twenty-four (24) cases.

The next hearing will take place on July 11, 2017 at 9:00 AM in the Community Room.

The Code Compliance Department has opened 492 cases from January 1, 2017 to May 31, 2017.

Permit Renewal Project

The Building and Code Compliance Department has been working on an expired permit renewal project. Since March 2016 when the project commenced, 114 Code Cases have been opened for expired permits, 46 of the Cases have gone to Special Magistrate Hearing.

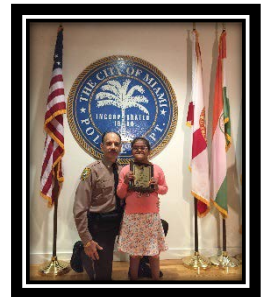
Town Manager Wins APWA Award:
