South Corridor Rapid Transit Project

South Dade Transitway from SW 34th Street to the south to the Dadeland South Metrorail Station on the north

The Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) is hosting two interactive workshops for the South Corridor Rapid Transit Project. The South Corridor is one of six Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit (SMART) Plan corridors being evaluated to assess and meet the travel and mobility needs of the County.

The workshops will follow an open-house format to allow participants to arrive at any time between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. No formal presentation will be given. It will take approximately 15-30 minutes to visit eight information stations at the workshop. DTPW representatives will be available to informally discuss the project and answer questions.
