Budget Workshop

1. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE & MOMENT OF SILENCE

Mayor Bell called the meeting to order at 6:33 PM. Deputy Town Clerk Mauricio Melinu called the roll. Mayor Bell led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Vice Mayor Loyzelle arrived at 6:51 PM.

A. Fiscal Year 2018-19 Proposed Budget

Town Manager Rafael Casals spoke about the increase in the Town's property values of 6.18 percent, and spoke on the proposed Fiscal Year 2018-19 Budget based on a max ceiling millage rate of 2.4739, compared to the existing 2.3907 millage rate for the adopted Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget.

There was discussion on the impact of the potential addition to the homestead exemption, the possibility of purchasing open land in the future, the fund balance reserve, the Town Center Building operating budget, and general fund revenues.

Town Attorney Chad Friedman spoke about the franchise fee agreement with Florida Power and Light, and the Town options to negotiate after the Miami-Dade County agreement expires in 2020.

There was discussion on individual department budgets, a potential accounting software upgrade to allow certain online payments, Town holiday lighting, Town Police budget, the potential of increasing revenue for the Town golf tournament, and possibility of retrofitting the Town Center Building for LED lighting.

Town Manager Rafael Casals spoke about Town occupied space in the Town Center Building and proposals the Town has received for the purchase of the Town Center Building.

There was discussion on the possibility of selling the Town Center Building and leasing back space, the potential of purchasing land and constructing a facility for Town operations, and the possibility of putting out a request for interest for the Town Center Building.

Mayor Bell spoke about Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funding.

Vice Mayor Loyzelle announced the Communities for a Lifetime Committee meeting on July 11.
