We Want to Hear from You

The Town is kindly requesting public comment to apply for the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity for a FY 2018 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The Town is eligible to apply for up to \$750,000 in the neighborhood revitalization, commercial revitalization and housing rehabilitation categories, and up to \$1.5 million in the economic development category. Construction activities funded through the CDBG Program must meet one of the following National Objectives:

- Provide benefits to low- and moderate-income persons; 19
- Prevent or eliminate slums or blighted conditions; or
- Meet a need of recent origin having a particular urgency.

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES:

The types of activities that CDBG funds may be used for include Stormwater improvement, paving roads and sidewalks, installing sewer and water lines, building a community center or park, making improvements to a sewage treatment plant, and rehabilitating low-income homes. Additional information regarding the range of activities that could be funded will be provided at the public hearing.
