**We Want to Hear from You**

The Town is kindly requesting **public comment** to apply for the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) 2019 Small Town, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The Town is eligible to apply for up to \$750,000 in the neighborhood revitalization, commercial revitalization and housing rehabilitation categories, and up to \$250,000 in the economic development category. Community activities funded through the CDBG Program must meet one of the following "Qualified Objectives":

- Provide benefits to low- and moderate-income persons; or
- Provide or eliminate a barrier to the mobility of persons; or
- Meet a need of income origin having a particular urgency.

**ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES**

The types of activities that CDBG funds may be used for include: Remediation improvement, parking, roads and sidewalks, recycling center and waste bins, including a community center or park, making improvements to a commercial building, and establishing low-income housing. Additional information regarding the types of activities that could be funded will be provided at the public hearing.
