

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-\_\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, URGING THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO EXPAND THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY'S NEIGHBORHOOD ACCESS TRAFFIC STUDY TO INCLUDE THE TOWN'S PORTION OF THE SW 87 AVENUE CORRIDOR; PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITTAL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cutler Bay (the "Town") Council supports municipalities' ability to improve the quality of life for their residents; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 23, 2019, the Village of Palmetto Bay (the "Village") Council adopted Resolution No. 2019-66, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," endorsing no right-turn signs along the SW 87 Avenue corridor between SW 168 Street and SW 184 Street and authorizing a traffic study as required by Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village's Resolution endorses the re-installation of no right-turn signs between the hours of 6:30 AM – 9:00 AM Monday-Friday along the SW 87 Avenue Corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village commissioned a Neighborhood Access Traffic Study prepared by Marlin Engineering, Inc. dated April 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village's Neighborhood Access Traffic Study studied the Malbrook Neighborhood and recommended the re-installation of no right-turn signs northbound along SW 87 Avenue Corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, many Town residents who utilize the SW 87 Avenue Corridor to travel northbound during the AM peak traffic hours experienced severe traffic back-ups when the prior no right-turn signs were installed by the Village and subsequently removed by Miami-Dade County Transportation and Public Works Department (M-DCTPWD); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town urges M-DCTPWD to further expand the Village's Neighborhood Access Traffic Study to include the traffic impacts/ back-up South of SW 184 Street within the Town's municipal boundaries; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town urges M-DCTPWD to complete any proposed roadway improvements/ expansion of the SW 168 Street Corridor before any no right-turn signs are installed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town finds that this Resolution will improve the quality of life, promote the health, safety and welfare of the Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.**     **Recitals.**     The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2.**     **Urging.**     The Town Council hereby urges the Miami-Dade County Transportation and Public Works Department to expand the Village of Palmetto Bay's Neighborhood Access Traffic Study to include the Town's portion of the SW 87 Avenue Corridor.

**Section 3.**     **Transmittal.**     The Town Council hereby directs the Town Clerk to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Miami-Dade County Mayor (Carlos A. Giménez), Miami-Dade County Commissioner District 8 (Daniella Levine Cava), and Miami-Dade County Transportation and Public Works Director (Alice N. Bravo).

**Section 4.**     **Effective Date.**     This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
