## **RESOLUTION 19-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, APPOINTING A NEW MEMBER TO THE YOUTH COUNCIL COMMITTEE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the School District has selected a candidate for appointment to the Committee, whom the Town Council wishes to confirm as a member of the Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that the adoption of this Resolution is in the best interest of the Town.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1. Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.
- **Section 2. Appointment of Committee Member.** The Town Council hereby appoints the Committee Member to fill the vacancy as shown on Exhibit "A."
- **Section 3. Effective Date**. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
