1. ORGANIZATION BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Cutler Bay Sr. High School is a Magnate High School (CBSHS) that serviced approximately 450 students during the 2018-19 school year. CBSHS is an A school with a four-year track record of excellence under the leadership of Principal, Mr. De La Torre. In addition, CBHS was ranked 86 in the state of Florida out of approximately 483 total schools. Presently, the school has a 73% participation rate in advanced academics. The demographic population constitutes of 82% minority enrollment and 62% of students are economically disadvantaged. Our school mission is to provide the opportunity for all students to excel at their highest potential.

2. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Cutler Bay Sr. High School (CBSHS) is a growing school; of which, most of the students are from the Town of Cutler Bay. The projected enrollment for 2019-2020 academic year, is expected at 515; a growth of 14% from the enrollment of 450 from the 2018-2019 school year.

The students at CBSHS have requested a Physics Program and in meeting the needs of our students, we are building a first time Physics program for the 2019-2020 school year. In so doing, the course was offered for the first time on the subject selection form. We have selected the textbook provided by the district; however, we will need laboratory equipment to support the curriculum.

The inception of this Physics course will provide a STEM curriculum that will allow students who are planning on entering careers in Medicine and Allied Health, Engineering, Mathematics, and Computer Science a diverse and complete background in science education. Research shows that students who take Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Calculus are at an advantage when applying to Universities and can apply for certain scholarships which require Physics on their transcripts.

CBSHS had offered all courses, except Physics. This new course will address the needs of our students and promote the understanding of the world around us with a hands-on approach.

3. METHOD OR STRATEGY FOR IMPLEMENTATION

We have a certified and experienced Physics instructor for the 2019-2020 school year and beyond. He will develop the academic program and align it with the Cambridge Physics course criteria.

The course begins in August of 2019-2020. The purchasing of equipment to build the laboratory will be ongoing due the cost and the funding that comes in throughout the school year. After the July budget conference in which the budget of the school is set, money will be allocated to begin the purchase of physics equipment.

The estimated final goal to purchase all needed equipment for both wet and dry labs is approximately \$75,000 to \$90,000. Our Physics teacher has written another grant in which he received \$10,000 for lab equipment. We are looking to increase this amount with further grants and budgeted monies from the overall school budget. We will be purchasing equipment throughout the school year in a staggered manner directly correlating with the labs needed during first in the year and so on.

4. EVALUATION OF THE PROJECT

Success will be measured in two ways. One metric of success is student enrollment in the course.; as supported on the Master Schedule. The second measure of success is student success on the AICE Cambridge Physics' exam which gives our students college credit, recognition and opportunities to Universities with highly competitive entrance requirements.
