A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AWARD OF \$7,500.00 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CUTLER BAY COMMUNITY FUND TO SUPPORT LOCAL NOTFOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS IN FURTHERING THE EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF THE TOWN'S YOUTH; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, COAST Academy Parent Association, Inc. ("CAPA"), DEEP Foundation, Inc. ("DEEP"), and Cutler Bay Senior High School submitted requests for funding that are in accordance with the Fund's mission; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council authorizes the Town Manager to award grant dollars in the amount of \$2,500.00 to CAPA for the Deering Estate NESTT Program Field Trips; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council authorizes the Town Manager to award grant dollars in the amount of \$2,500.00 to DEEP for the Cutler Bay Scuba Program; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council authorizes the Town Manager to award grant dollars in the amount of \$2,500.00 to Cutler Bay Senior High School for the Physics Program; and

WHEREAS, the Town finds that this resolution will promote the health, safety and welfare of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
