



IMPACT OF MODEL

	DURING IHAT	POST IHAT
ER Admissions	↓ 81%	↓ 67% 1-year post
Partial Hospitalization Admissions	↓ 90%	↓ 79% 6-month post
Inpatient/Residential Admissions	↓ 79%	↓ 74% 6-month post

FLORIDA PRESENCE

- Model available in Palm Beach County through Aware Recovery Care
- Full licensure anticipated in September
- IHAT Institute plans to conduct research and raise awareness throughout Southern Florida
