

RESOLUTION NO. 19-__

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Cutler Bay's (the 'Town') Department of Public Works is responsible for overseeing various Capital Improvement Projects and conducting studies to determine the need for future infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, Town staff has prepared a comprehensive Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") to solicit bids and identify the best qualified consultants to assist the Town with Professional Engineering Services ("Services"); and

WHEREAS, the Services include General Civil Engineering, Transportation Planning and Engineering, updating the current Stormwater Master Plan, and Landscape Architecture; and

WHEREAS, Section 24-45 of the Town's Code requires the Town Manager to obtain authorization from the Town Council to advertise solicitations for bids and proposals prior to advertising the solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has reviewed the RFQ and desires to authorize its advertisement; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the residents of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Authorization. The Town Manager is hereby authorized to advertise and issue a RFQ for Professional Engineering Services for the Town, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
