RESOLUTION NO. 19-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO MARLIN ENGINEERING, INC. FOR DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE SAGA BAY 1.7 SUBBASIN WATER QUALITY IMPROVEMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- **WHEREAS,** the Town of Cutler Bay (the "Town) adopted the Stormwater Master Plan via Resolution No. 08-50 for the purpose of identifying opportunities to protect surface water quality and reduce flooding within residential neighborhoods; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Town adopted the 2010 Miami-Dade County Local Mitigation Strategy (the "Local Mitigation Strategy") via Resolution No. 14-55 for the purposes of mitigating potential hazards within the Town; and
- WHEREAS, the Saga Bay 1.7 Sub-Basin (the "Sub-Basin") was identified as a priority project in both the Stormwater Master Plan and Local Mitigation Strategy; and
- WHEREAS, on September 17, 2014, the Town Council adopted Resolution No. 14-63, authorizing the Town Manager to negotiate and execute a Non-Exclusive Professional Services Agreement (the "Agreement") with Marlin Engineering, Inc. (the "Consultant"), among others, to provide various engineering and architectural services for the Town; and
- WHEREAS, in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and the provisions set forth in Resolution No. 14-63, the Public Works Department solicited a proposal from Consultant to provide Design Services (the "Services"); and
- **WHEREAS**, Town Staff has determined that the Consultant would be the best suited to provide the Services for the Saga Bay 1.7 Sub-Basin Water Quality Improvement(s) Project (the "Project"); and
- **WHEREAS,** Consultant has submitted a proposal to the Town a total fee for the Services for the Project in an amount not to exceed \$78,547.99, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A"; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Town has budgeted for the Services for the Project within the 2019-20 Operating Budget and the Project will be funded from the Town's Stormwater Utility Fund; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that this Resolution is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.
Section 2. <u>Authorization</u> . In accordance with the terms and conditions of Resolution No. 14-63, the Town Council authorizes the Town Manager to issue a purchase order to Consultant, in an amount not to exceed \$78,547.99, for the Services for the Project, as provided in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein.
Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
