SUBJECT: Resolution Retroactively Authorizing Extension of Interlocal Agreement between Miami-Dade County and the Town of Cutler Bay for Local Police Patrol Services for Additional 90 Days

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board approve a 90-day extension to the Interlocal Agreement between Miami-Dade County (the County), by and through its police department, the Miami-Dade Police Department (MDPD), and the Town of Cutler Bay (the Town), for the purpose of providing local police patrol services to the Town, and retroactively authorize the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to extend the term of the current agreement from August 20, 2019 to November 18, 2019.

Scope

The extension will grant the County and the Town an additional 90 days in which a final contract for local police patrol services can be negotiated. The Town is in District 8, which is represented by Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

Regular quarterly installments for services rendered will continue to be made to Miami-Dade County in accordance with the proposed agreement.

Track Record/Monitor

The 90-day extension will be administered by Chief George A. Perez, of the MDPD's South Operations Division. Also, the extension will be monitored for fiscal compliance by Assistant Director Gustavo Knoepffler, of the MDPD's Departmental Services.

Background


The MDPD provides local police patrol services upon request from various municipalities. These are comprehensive police patrol services that include enforcing the law, preventing and deterring crime, arresting criminal offenders, preventive and directive patrolling, maintaining public order, and providing services to the community. Such activities include, but are not limited to, directing and enforcing traffic laws, directing, controlling, and preventing traffic crashes, responding to emergency and non-emergency calls for service, conducting field interviews, arresting criminal offenders, issuing traffic citations, and reporting daily quality of life issues.

The Board, through Resolution No. R-513-14, authorized the execution of an Interlocal Agreement between the County and the Town for the provision of local police patrol services to the Town. The Interlocal Agreement between the County and the Town provided for a five-year term which expires as of midnight on August 20, 2019.

Over the past few months, the MDPD and the Town have participated in productive negotiations but have been unable to reach an agreement to date. As such, in a letter dated July 24, 2019, the Town of Cutler Bay formally requested a 90-day extension in order to continue contract negotiations. The current Interlocal Agreement between the MDPD and the Town will expire at midnight on August 20, 2019, while the Board of County Commissioners is on recess. The implementation of the current Interlocal Agreement has been of mutual benefit to both the County and the Town, and both the County and the Town desire to renew the Interlocal Agreement. An additional 90 days would allow MDPD and the Town of Cutler Bay sufficient time to reach an agreement on all outstanding contract provisions.
