#### #2020Census

As of May 13, 2020,  $\underline{66\%}$  of Cutler Bay has responded to the Census. Let's aim to be 100% counted so we can get 100% of the funds our community needs!

The results of the #2020Census will inform decisions and proportionately allocate hundreds of billions of dollars in federal funding to communities across the country based on the amount of people that get counted—that includes hospitals, fire departments, school lunch programs, and other critical programs and service. It will also determine how many seats in Congress each state gets.

Responding can be done online, by phone, or by mail and should take just a few minutes to do. You should have received your invitation in the mail already with instructions on how to participate. If you have not, the Census will be sending additional mailings soon.
