BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

Project Title: Cutler Bay Streetscape Enhancement

Amount Awarded: \$12,500

Neat Streets Miami is a Miami-Dade County board dedicated to the maintenance and beautification of transportation gateways, corridors and connections. The board's Million Trees Miami campaign has a goal of 1 million trees planted by 2020 and a 30 percent tree canopy throughout Miami-Dade County. In order to reach this goal, Street Trees Matching

Grant program, funded by Miami-Dade County, engages municipalities, non-profits and community organizations in planting native or Florida-friendly trees on Miami-Dade's corridors and gateways. Grants of \$5,000 to \$25,000 will be awarded to those communities who can demonstrate the greatest benefits for residents, employers and visitors and are able to provide a stewardship plan for our joint investment.

On December 13, 2016, the Town submitted a grant application requesting funding on behalf of the Public Works Department. Neat Streets Miami has awarded the Town a \$12,500 matching grant to plant fifty (50) trees on the swale and public right-of-way of various local and/or county roads throughout the Town.

RECOMMENDATION

We recommend that the attached Resolution be adopted, authorizing the Town Manger to execute Fiscal Year 2017 Neat Streets Miami Street Tree Matching Grant contract in the amount of \$12,500.
