REQUEST

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH DEBRA E. EASTMAN, MMC AS THE TOWN CLERK; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT RELATED TO THE SAME; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

At the Town Council Workshop held on March 29, 2017, by consensus, the Mayor was requested to work with the Interim Town Clerk Debra Eastman to discuss a possible employment agreement. There was also discussion regarding that an additional Town Council Workshop be held tentatively on April 17, 2017 in the case that the Interim Town Clerk and Mayor not reach an agreement.

An agreement was reached between the Interim Town Clerk and the Mayor and it was subsequently vetted by
